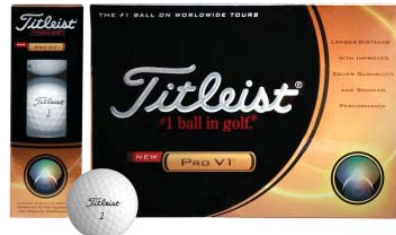

Championship Information

FORMAT: All players will play 18-holes of stroke play on Monday, August 9th and Tuesday, August 10th. Tee times will run from 7:00am - 2:00pm both days. All players will be re-paired for Tuesday's round by score, with the leaders going off last. There will be an awards ceremony and trophy presentation following the conclusion of play on Tuesday at approximately 6:00pm on the veranda adjacent to the clubhouse.

ELEGIBILITY: All players must be between the ages of 13-18 on August 10th, 2010, must be an amateur golfer as defined by the USGA, and must not have entered their first year of college.

PAR AND YARDAGE: Timberlin Golf Club will play at 6,680 yards for the Boys Championship and 5,650 yards for the Girls Championship, and a par of 36-36 -- 72.

WHAT'S AT STAKE: In addition to national exposure to college coaches across the country, both the Boys and Girls Champion will receive \$500 pro shop credit, as well as numerous tournament exemptions. The Boys Champion will receive invites to the International Junior Masters (Aurora, NY), Bobby Chapman Invitational (Spartenburg, SC) and Joe Cheves Junior (Morganton, NC). The Girls Champion and Boys Runner-Up will also receive an invitation to the Joe Cheves Junior (Morganton, NC). The estimated prize payout for the tournament is \$2,850 pro shop credit.

SPECTATORS: Spectators are encouraged to attend, and admission and parking are free of charge. All spectators are required to stay in the rough at all times and may not talk to players during the competition.

About the Stan Trojanowski Northern Junior

The Stan Trojanowski Northern Junior is a 36-hole event contested over two days at Timberlin Golf Club in Berlin, Connecticut. Our goal is to provide the same red-carpet treatment seen at the highest level of competition and we strive to provide amenities not seen at most junior events, such as standard bearers and live tournament scoring. The tournament is run each year in memory of Stan Trojanowski, father of Cindy Paladino and Gary Trojanowski. A golfer himself, his personality and willingness to help others will never be forgotten in the people he met both on and off the golf course. The Stan Trojanowski Northern Junior was established in 2002 in memory of his death on August 21st, 2001.

2009 Tournament Results

Griffin, Partridge Victorious at 2009 Northern Junior

Michael Griffin, a Torrington, Conn. native, shot a final round 71 (-1) to best John Jackopsic of West Hartford, Conn. by a single shot to capture the Boys Championship. Jackopsic recorded the low round of the tournament with a final round 68 (-4), and finished more than an hour ahead of the final group. However, Griffin, who started the day three shots behind overnight leader Monte Mullen, closed with a steller back nine of 34 including a birdie at the difficult par-4 15th to claim the title.

Katie Partridge of Bloomfield, Conn. entered the final round of the Girls Championship with a four shot lead. Erica Barnes of Berlin, Conn. made an early move and would own a share of the lead throughout much of the afternoon. However, Barnes' bogey five on the par-4 17th would give Partridge a one shot lead going into the last hole, and a par on the last would secure a hard earned victory.
